I have completed the technical review of the Technical Memorandum for No Further Action, PSC 30, Building 313 - Mop Rack Drying Area, NAS Cecil Field, dated January 2001 (received February 1, 2001), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. Surface soil contaminated with PAHs were excavated to a depth of one foot, resulting in 63.64 tons being excavated, transported and disposed off site. Based on the results reported in the Technical Memorandum, the Department concurs with the recommendation of no further action for soils. The Department also concurs that the site should retain the BRAC classification of Yellow to denote that the Operable Unit 7, Site 16, groundwater plume underlies the site.

The Department's concurrence is predicated on the information provided by the SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM. Therefore, any new information contradicting the basis for this concurrence, may require further investigation or remedial actions.
