Dear Mr. Davidson:

I have completed the technical review of the Technical Memorandum for No Further Action, PSC 50, Facility 98, NAS Cecil Field, dated January 2001 (received February 1, 2001), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. Surface soil contaminated with petroleum was excavated to a depth of one foot, resulting in 188.4 tons being excavated, transported and disposed off site. Based on the results reported in the Technical Memorandum, the Department concurs with the recommendation of no further action. The Department also concurs with the recommendation that the BRAC color classification be changed from Yellow to Dark Green to denote that a release of hazardous substance has occurred and all remedial actions have been taken.

The Department's concurrence is predicated on the information provided by the SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM. Therefore, any new information contradicting the basis for this concurrence, may require further investigation or remedial actions.
