

## **Cecil Commerce Center and Cecil Field Airport Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Steering Committee Meeting Minutes Tuesday, July 17, 2001**

### **Introduction**

The July meeting of the Cecil Field Steering Committee was held in the Conference Room of Building 82 at the Cecil Field Airport on July 17, 2001 at 6:55 PM. The meeting was a joint meeting of the Steering Committee and the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Cleanup Team (BCT).

Meeting minutes from the April Steering Committee meeting were approved with no changes.

### **Meeting Agendas**

Future RAB agenda topics were discussed. The following are the suggested agenda topics for the October RAB meeting:

- OU 9, Sites 57 and 58 (824A/Day Tank 1 and Building 312) Groundwater
- FOST Update
- Sites Update
- Sites 36/37 Remedial Action (data or possible field trip)

Other possible topics for the October meeting or subsequent meetings include:

- Update on Status of Railroad Tracks
- Update on PSC 51, Golf Course
- Update on Equestrian Center Area, Building 610 and PSC 42

The possibility of reducing the number of meetings per year was mentioned. The usefulness of quarterly meetings to the community was discussed. The Steering Committee decided that meetings should remain quarterly. It also was mentioned that community interest might increase due to upcoming development activities (i.e. equestrian center).

The dates of the October and January meetings were tentatively set for the third Tuesdays of the month, October 16<sup>th</sup> and January 15<sup>th</sup>, respectively.
