

Cecil Commerce Center and Cecil Field Airport Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Steering Committee Meeting Minutes Tuesday, October 16, 2001

Introduction

The October meeting of the Cecil Field Steering Committee was held in the Conference Room of Building 82 at the Cecil Field Airport on October 16, 2001 at 6:30 PM. The meeting was a joint meeting of the Steering Committee and the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Cleanup Team (BCT).

The following Steering Committee members, Partnering Team members and administrative personnel attended: Richard Darby (Community Co-Chair), Diane Peterson (Alternate Community Co-Chair), Scott Glass (SOUTHDIV), Mark Davidson (SOUTHDIV), David Grabka (FDEP), Mark Speranza (TtNUS), and Rob Simcik (TtNUS).

Meeting minutes from the July Steering Committee meeting were approved with no changes.

Meeting Agendas

Future RAB agenda topics were discussed. The following are the suggested agenda topics for the January RAB meeting:

- OU 9, Sites 57 and 58 Groundwater
- Sites Update
- Sites 36/37 Air Sparging System Construction Update (with photos)

Scott Glass raised a question as to whether the Cecil Field Community Relations Plan (CRP) needed to be updated. It was prepared in July 1991 and hasn't been updated to reflect changes such as the closing of the facility and transfers of property. Richard Darby and Diane Peterson did not feel that an update of the plan was necessary because the RAB is still active, and close communications between the Navy and the community have been maintained. Everyone felt that it would be more appropriate to revisit the issue at the next Five-Year Review because at that time the RAB will likely be inactive and an updated CRP could help redefine the post-RAB relationship between the Navy and the community.

The dates of the January and April meetings were tentatively set for the third Tuesdays of the month, January 15th and April 16th, respectively.
