I have reviewed the Groundwater Monitoring Report, 1st Quarter, 1st Year, North-South Apron Plume, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated September 20, 2001 (received September 21, 2001). The results indicate that contaminant concentrations have decreased in several wells, while remaining static in one well. Monitoring at the site should proceed as specified in the March 16, 2001 Natural Attenuation Monitoring Plan Approval Order.
