I have completed my review of the Source Removal Report, Excavation of Petroleum-Contaminated Soil at Potential Source of Contamination 42, Steam Generating Plant and Storehouse in the Yellow Water Weapons Area, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated May 2001 (received June 4, 2001), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The report adequately documents that 2,420.36 tons of soil contaminated with PAHs, TRPH, arsenic, antimony and barium were excavated and disposed offsite in accordance with the approved Action Memorandum for this site.
