


I have completed the technical review of the Sampling and Analysis Report Addendum, dated November 1999 (received November 15, 1999) submitted for the above-referenced building. Although manganese detected in monitoring CEF-222LS-1 exceeds the FDEP Secondary Standard (50  $\mu$ /l) and the established NAS Cecil Field background value (91 $\mu$ /l), FDEP concurs with the recommendation of no further action for the building. This is based on no known documentation, storage, or releases of hazardous substances that would conclude that this detection is the result of past disposal practices.

FDEP's concurrence is predicated on the information provided by the SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM. Therefore, any new information contradicting the basis for this concurrence, may require further investigation or remedial actions.
