I have completed my review of the Draft Action Memorandum for Non-Time Critical Removal Action for Operable Unit 5, Site 15, Blue 10 Ordnance Disposal Area, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated June 2012 (received by e-mail on June 1, 2012), prepared by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The document was a resubmittal of the May 2012 version but with EPA legal comments and the Navy's response to those comments incorporated into the June 2012 document. The preferred remedy proposed in the Non-Time Critical Removal Action (identified in the Feasibility Study (FS) as Alternative 2C) is Areas of Concern, Select Surface and Shallow Subsurface munitions and explosives of concern (MEC) and Anomaly Removal with mechanical excavation and manual investigation and removal. Based on my review, the proposed action appears to be a reasonable response to MEC that may remain at Site 15. Please note that based on the amount, type and distribution of MEC identified and remediated under Alternative 2C, the Department may conclude that further investigation and remediation of MEC would need to be conducted, possibly alternatives 3C or 4C as identified in the FS.
