CERCLA Non-Time-Critical Removal Action

The U.S. Navy, in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, encourages the public to comment on the Action Memorandum for a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Non-Time Critical Removal Action for a Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) Site known as Operable Unit 5, Site 15 - Blue 10 Ordnance Disposal Area at the former Naval Air Station Cecil Field, Jacksonville, Florida. The Action Memorandum recommends removal of surface and shallow subsurface munitions and explosives of concern (MEC)/material potentially presenting an explosive hazard (MPPEH), munitions-related items, and metallic non-munitions debris within the former ordnance disposal area and along access ways at Site 15.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD.
The Navy invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the Action Memorandum during the 30-day public comment period held from August 9 through September 10, 2012. Public comments must be submitted in writing and postmarked or e-mailed no later than September 10, 2012.
