1.0 INTRODUCTION

This Base Realignment and Closure program Phase II Sampling and Analysis Outline briefly describes and proposes a plan for assessment of Building 607 at Naval Air Station Cecil Field. Building 607 is located on the north side of Main Road, between Guard Post Number 1 and the Yellow Water Weapons Compound (Figure 1). The facility is referred to as the Yellow Water Weapons Department Administration Building in the Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) Report (ABB Environmental Services, Inc. [ABB-ES], 1994).

2.0 EBS COLOR DESIGNATION

Building 607 was color-coded Grey in the EBS because a 1,000-gallon underground storage tank (UST) for heating oil was formerly located on the property. According to facility contacts, the UST was removed in 1992. No documentation of a tank closure assessment has been located for this facility. No other concerns were identified in the EBS Report.


3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

Potential environmental concerns associated with the UST will be addressed in accordance with the Tank Management Plan (ABB-ES, 1997). No additional Phase II sampling or analysis is recommended for this facility. A recommendation to reclassify the color code for Building 607 is pending a satisfactory resolution of UST related issues.


