Dear Mr. Sanford:

I have completed my review of the Final Third Five-Year Review, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated April 2011 (received April 13, 2011), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. This document evaluated the remedial actions at twelve operable units. The remedies at Operable Unit 3, Site 8 and Operable Unit 10, Site 25 have been determined to be complete, no further action is necessary, and those sites are not required to be assessed in subsequent Five-Year Reviews. The remedies at Operable Unit 1, Sites 1 and 2; Operable Unit 2, Sites 5 and 17; Operable Unit 5, Site 15; Operable Unit 7, Site 16; Operable Unit 10, Site 21; Operable Unit 12, Site 32; and Operable Unit 9, Sites 36, 37, 57 and 58; have been determined to be protective of human health and the environment in the short-term, are expected to be protective in the long-term, and there is evidence that the remedies as specified in their respective Records of Decision will ultimately attain ARARs.

The remedies at Operable Unit 8, Site 3; Operable Unit 11, Site 45; and Operable Unit 9, Site 59; have been determined to be protective of human health and the environment in the short-term, but the long-term protectiveness of the remedies has been deferred. For Operable Unit 8, Site 3, the determination of the long-term protectiveness of the remedy is deferred until an evaluation of actions necessary to address the groundwater plume exceedences downgradient near Rowell Creek is conducted during the next five year review period. For Operable Unit 11, Site 45, the determination of the long-term protectiveness of the remedy is deferred until an evaluation of actions necessary to address plume migration is conducted during the next five year review period. For Operable Unit 9, Site 59, the determination of the long-term protectiveness of the

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remedy is deferred until further data is collected to provide accurate contaminant concentration trends during the next five-year review period.
