SITE 3, OU8 ROD Comments:

FDEP comments by Mike Deliz via phone conversation on Tuesday June 23, 1998.

- 1) Page 2-3; Section 2.2; 3rd paragraph; Change whole paragraph to past tense. This stuff has already occurred.
- 2) Page 2-9; Last paragraph; second to last sentence: Typo: Change Top to Topo, as in topographic.
- 3) Page 2-10; First sentence; This discussion is not correct. The site is not under the UST program it is only under the CERCLA program. Just remove the sentence discussing it dealing with site under petroleum program.
- 4) Page 2-10; First sentence; Typo: Xylene is spelled incorrectly.
- 5) Page 2-19; First couple sentences: Dust control; Note that sampling of the dust has been conducted and no PCBs were identified. Also note that all background "high cut" values have been accepted by NAS as previously discussed with Mark Speranza.
Re-check the 8 identified organics against High Cut values and edit out if fall below.
- 6) Page 2-20; Identify if vapor extraction is impacting or designed to reduce organic concentrations in the subsurface soils. NOTE: Mark Speranza, Mike Deliz is making this an action item to partnering team.
- 7) Page 2-21; Re-screen against High Cut values to see if Organics are still a problem.
- 8) Page 2-22; Second paragraph; Re-check 18 identified contaminants against high cut values to see if any drop out.
- 9) Page 2-25; 4th and 5th paragraphs; check against high cut values.
- 10) Page 2-39; Implantation of Institutional Controls. There is no such thing as "State of Florida Environmental Land use Restrictions. Need to remove.
- 11) Page 2-41; Table 2-5 page 2 of 2; last column; Take out "although these values are not propagated...". This column is considered an ARAR by FDEP because it is covered under two existing Florida Guidance and therefore does not need to be included. Or at least it doesn't need to be identified as propagated.

DRAFT SITE 11 ROD

Only comment is to compare against high cut values to see if anything drops out. Mike will notify by EOB Wednesday (6/24) if any additional comments. If he doesn't call, assume no additional comments from the state.

Mark Speranza Action Item:

Need to make request for comments on the Decision Document by partnering team.
