Dear Mr. Glass:

The Department of Environmental Protection concurs with the Navy's Record of Decision (ROD) dated July 1999 for the selected remedy at Site 8, Operable Unit 3, Naval Air Station Cecil Field.

The remedial action at Site 8 will address risk reduction in groundwater. The proposed remedy for groundwater is monitored natural attenuation and institutional controls to prevent its consumption.

The estimated cost of the preferred alternative at Site 8 is \$465,000 and will take about 30 years to complete. We understand the responsible party, the U.S. Navy, will be performing the Superfund remedial action, so a State cost share under Superfund will not be necessary.
