Notice Of Public Comment Period On the U.S. Navy's Proposed Plan Recommending No Further Action For Operable Unit (OU) 4 At NAS Cecil Field

The Navy, as part of its responsibilities under the Installation Restoration (IR) Program, has completed a Proposed Plan for OU 4 at NAS Cecil Field. The proposed plan is a document that summarizes alternatives that may be used to remove or control a source of contamination at a site and identifies the preferred alternative for remedial action. Based upon the results of a risk assessment, the Proposed Plan for OU 4 recommends that *no further action* is necessary because the site does not pose a threat to human health and the environment.

OU 4, also known as Site 10, the Rubble Disposal Area, is located northwest of the meeting point of Rowell Creek and Sal Taylor Creek. The site was used as a rubble disposal area from the 1950s through the 1960s. Wastes disposed of at the site included building demolition debris, tires, asphalt, and furniture; no hazardous wastes were reported to have been disposed of at OU 4.

The public is encouraged to review and comment on the U.S. Navy's Proposed Plan. *The draft Proposed Plan will be discussed at the July 15th Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting which is open to the public. The RAB meeting will be held at 7:00 p.m. at NAS Cecil Field's Bachelor Officer's Quarters.*

A public comment period for the final Proposed Plan is scheduled from **July 21 through August 21, 1997**. Comments may be written or verbal and should be submitted to the address listed below. Copies of the final Proposed Plan and a fact sheet summarizing the proposal will be available for review on July 21st at the Charles D. Webb Wesconnett Branch of the Jacksonville Public Library, 6887 103rd Street, Jacksonville, Florida, 32210, (904) 778-7305.
