

Dear Mr. Davidson:

I have completed my review of the Draft Remedial Investigation Report, Operable Unit 9, Site 59, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated February 2006 (received March 1, 2006), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. I have the following comments on the report:

- (1) Page 1-2, second paragraph, third sentence, please change "Conservation" to "Protection".
- (2) Page 5-4, second paragraph, first sentence, please change "ethane" to "ethene".
- (3) In Section 6.0, there was no discussion of the naphthalene or TRPH associated with the Building 815 Wash Rack Area.
- (4) In Table 7-1, the GCTLs for ethylbenzene and toluene are incorrect. They should be 30 and 40 µg/L, respectively.
- (5) In Section 6.0, there should be a discussion of retardation factors with respect to TCE and naphthalene. A range of retardation factors for each contaminant should be presented.
