Dear Mr. Davidson:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the subject report and conditionally concurs with the disposition of no further action and the BRAC classification recommendation of 4/Dark Green. However, there are several points within the report that should be clarified before the report is finalized.:

1. The removal action was conducted under an Action Memorandum in accordance to the National Contingency Plan (NCP), 40 CFR 300.415. The report needs to reference this action memorandum and clearly state if requirements of the action memorandum were met.
2. Page 4-1. The report gives the procedures used to analyze samples from Phase I. What of the samples from Phases II through IV?
3. The report must have a clear statement regarding the current condition of the soils at the site. The soils removal was suppose to reach residential levels and therefore no land use controls are required. However, the text is not clear regarding the current condition.
