
Dear Mr. Kizer:

I have completed the technical review of the Annual Monitoring Report, dated June 1998 (received June 16, 1998) submitted for the above-referenced facility. FDEP does not concur with the recommendation of continued quarterly sampling. The sampling frequency should be changed to semi-annual and monitoring well CEF-372-01 should be deleted from this monitoring program. Monitoring wells CEF-372-07, CEF-372-13, CEF-372-14, and CEF-372-20 should be analyzed semi-annually for EPA Method 602 and 610. This monitoring program supersedes the Monitoring Only Plan approved February 4, 1997.
