


I have reviewed the Contamination Assessment Report (CAR) Addendum dated March 1996 (received March 20, 1996), submitted for this site. I found all the documents submitted to date to be adequate to meet the contamination assessment requirements of Rules 62-770.600 and 62-770.630, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Therefore, you must now submit a Remedial Action Plan (RAP) in accordance with Rule 62-770.700, F.A.C. The RAP should include two additional water table monitoring wells along the bank of Sal Taylor Creek. These wells should be installed in the immediate vicinity of soil boring 95I-58 and 93-5I-86, which had OVA headspace results of 300 ppm and 460 ppm, respectively. These wells should be sampled and analyzed for the Kerosene Analytical Group as defined in Chapter 62-770, F.A.C. (these wells may also be installed and sampled as part of the base-wide BRAC gray site investigations).

Please submit the RAP to the Department within sixty (60) days. If you should have any questions concerning this review, please contact me at (904) 921-9991.
