I have completed my review of five Operations and Maintenance (O & M) Status Reports, Bioventing and Biosparging Systems, South Fuel Farm, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The reports reviewed included the First Quarter 2002 O & M Report dated July 2002 (received August 1, 2002), the Third Quarter 2002 O & M Report dated July 2003 (received July 16, 2003), the Fourth Quarter 2002 O & M Report dated September 2003 (received September 18, 2003), the First Quarter 2003 O & M Report dated October 2003 (received October 23, 2003) and the Annual O & M Report that covered the time period between June 1, 2002 – June 30, 2003, dated December 2003 (received December 10, 2003).
