I have completed my review of the Remedial Action Completion Report, Soil Removal, Day Tank 1, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated November 2004 (received by e-mail on November 29, 2004), prepared and submitted by T N & Associates, Inc. The report needs to certify that the limits of the excavation (except for a change because of the depth to the water table) conducted by T N & Associates and its subcontractor, CBI, Inc., were the limits as planned in Tetra Tech's Dig and Haul Package, Former Day Tank 1 Retention Pond, NAS Cecil Field, dated July 16, 2004, and approved by the Department on August 11, 2004. The e-mailed report also was missing figures and the appendices of the report. Also, the report should include the Non-Hazardous Waste Manifests referred to at the end of Section 2.2. Please note that the Department will require that groundwater sampling and analysis be conducted in the excavated areas of Day Tank 1 to determine whether groundwater has been adversely affected.
