(RCRA) Facility Investigation (RFI) Work Plans

Dear Captain Nold:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation (RFI) Work Plans for Zones C and I which were transmitted with your August 17, 1994, letter. In accordance with your August 30, 1994, letter, EPA has delayed reviewing the Zones C and I RFI Work Plans. The two week delay was requested assuming imminent revision and approval of the Zone H RFI Work Plan, which has not been the case. The purpose for the delay was to allow comments on the Zone H RFI Work Plan and from the August 9, 1994, Zones C and I Scoping Meeting to be incorporated into the Zones C and I RFI Work Plans. The Zone H RFI Work Plan is scheduled to be delivered to EPA by October 28, 1994. EPA sees no reason to further delay the submission of Zones C and I RFI Work Plans. In accordance with Condition II.G.1. of the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) portion of your RCRA Permit, EPA has determined that the Zones C and I RFI Work Plans are due to EPA within two weeks of receipt of this letter.

Note that until the Zones C and I RFI Work Plans are approved, Naval Base Charleston has not fulfilled the requirements for Permit Condition II.C., RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) or Permit Condition II.G.1., Plan and Report Requirements, of the HSWA portion of your RCRA Permit.


To expedite review of the revised RFI Work Plans, EPA requests receipt of seven (7) copies. The revised RFI Work Plans must be submitted to:

Failure to submit approvable Zone C and I RFI Work Plans by the prescribed deadline will be considered a failure to submit a complete and approvable RFI Work Plan as required by Permit Condition II.G.1. of the HSWA portion of the RCRA Permit. Failure to submit approvable Zone C and I RFI Work Plans by the prescribed deadline may result in sanctions pursuant to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. 6901 et seq, as amended by the Federal Facilities Compliance Act of October 6, 1992. If further time is required for the submission of the approvable RFI Work Plans, then specific justification must be presented.
