
On January 30, 1995, the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) received authorization from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to implement portions of the RCRA Corrective Action program covered under the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) requirements. Consequently, the Department and the U.S. EPA have reviewed the above referenced Zone H RFI Report in accordance with applicable State and Federal Regulations, and the Charleston Naval Shipyard's Hazardous Waste Permit, effective June 5, 1990. Based on this review the Charleston Naval Shipyard has not adequately fulfilled the requirements of Permit Condition IV.C.4.

Attached are comments provided by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Department. Within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this letter, please make the specified changes and resubmit the Zone H RFI Report in final form to the Department and U.S. EPA.
