To fulfill the requirements of condition II.A.2 of the RCRA Part B permit issued to the Navy by DHEC and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Navy acknowledges a potential new site located at the Charleston Naval Complex

The Navy proposes to include this site as an Area of Concern (AOC) 721, an area next to Noisette Creek in Zone A. The potential new AOC was discovered while evaluating the data for the existing SWMU 42. Designating this area as an AOC was discussed during the November 2001 BCT meeting. The AOC will be added by addendum to the Zone A, RCRA Facility Assessment. Proposed future actions will be included in the addendum.
