Based on the review of the RFI Report Addendum and the November 16, 2001 responses, the Department approves no further action (NFA) as the final corrective action decision for SWMU 164. The Department's position is detailed in the enclosures (memorandum Mansour Malik to Susan Peterson and in Susan Peterson's comments).

The Navy should note that the Permit has not been modified to document the above stated decision for SWMU 164. The current Permit classification for SWMU 164 is CSI. The Department will make the necessary changes to the Permit during the next Permit Modification to document this NFA decision.

To note, the Navy should satisfy all requirements of other program areas of the Department as deemed appropriate. Further, the CNC should note that the Department's approval is based on the information provided to date. Any new information found to be contradictory might require further action.
