
Dear Ms. Daniell:

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) has reviewed the above sampling plan, dated August 2001 and received August 10, 2001 according to applicable State and Federal Regulations, and the Charleston Naval Complex Hazardous Waste Permit (Permit), effective September 17, 1998.

The Division of Hydrogeology has prepared comments (memo: Bergstrand to Peterson, January 22, 2002) that require resolution prior to issuing an approval.
