

Dear Paul:

On behalf of the U.S. Navy Southern Division Naval Facilities Engineering Command, CH2M-Jones requests the installation of 13 Geoprobe sampling locations to be installed by CH2M Hill's subcontractor Columbia.

The Geoprobe sampling locations will be advanced to a maximum depth of approximately 40 feet below land surface and sampled for VOCs. Groundwater samples will be collected from approximately 10 feet, 25 feet, and 40 feet below land surface. The borings will not be completed as a groundwater monitoring well. The attached Figure 1 from the sampling and analysis plan presents the locations of the 13 proposed Geoprobe locations. The boring abandonment will be performed in accordance with the South Carolina Well Standards and Regulations (R.61-71), including submittal of Water Well Record Form HDI (9-77).

CH2M-Jones's subcontractor has scheduled to complete this work in early March 2002. If you have any questions, comments, or require additional information please do not hesitate to contact us.



- ▬ SWMU Boundary


