Dear Mr. Litton:

To fulfill the requirements of condition II.A.2 of the RCRA Part B permit issued to the Navy by DHEC and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Navy acknowledges a potential new site located at the Charleston Naval Complex

The Navy proposes to include this site as an Area of Concern (AOC) 724, an un-exploded ordnance area (UXO). The site is an area bounded by Bainbridge Avenue, Building 650 and its parking lot, Halsey Street, and a line drawn from Building 650's parking lot to Bainbridge Avenue in Zone H. The potential new AOC was discovered while installing a replacement waterline in the existing SWMU 9. The AOC will be added by addendum to the Zone H, RCRA Facility Investigation. Proposed future actions will be included in the addendum.
