

Dear Mr. Hunt:

EnSafe/Allen & Hoshall (E/A&H) is pleased to submit the 2 copies of the *Final Comprehensive RFI Work Plan* page changes and 9 copies of the *Corrective Action Management Plan, Revision 1 (CAMP)*. Per your direction, E/A&H has also forwarded copies of these documents to the BRAC Cleanup Team (BCT) identified on the attached distribution lists.

As a matter of convenience to the Navy, E/A&H has been providing direct distribution of documents to members of the BCT. Recently, some concerns arose regarding this arrangement that I would like to bring to your attention. As you know, all document submittals required by the Charleston Naval Shipyard (CNSY) Part B Permit must be submitted under cover letter of CNSY. Shipment of these documents, which may have regulatory deadlines cannot occur without the cover letter. E/A&H strives to prepare documents in a timely manner that will allow sufficient time for CNSY to review the documents, draft a cover letter, and return a copy of the letter to E/A&H so that distribution can be made in compliance with deadlines. Recently, on two separate occasions, E/A&H prepared submittals that were delayed as a result of CNSY Code 106 personnel. The first incident occurred when the CAMP was prepared and ready for delivery on 12 May 1995. A cover letter was not received from Code 106 until 23 May 1995. The second incident occurred on 19 May 1995 when E/A&H provided Code 106 with 3 copies of laboratory quality assurance plans (QAPs) that were to be submitted to USEPA immediately. It was E/A&H's understanding that Code 106 was responsible for submittal of those documents to USEPA as part of the corrective action plan related to the ongoing laboratory audit issue. Four days later on 23 May 1995, these

documents were unexpectedly returned to E/A&H by Code 106 with a request to ship them overnight to USEPA. Because of the extenuating circumstances surrounding the sensitivity of the laboratory audit issue, with USEPA, E/A&H agreed to ship the documents rather than cause any further delays which may have undermined the Navy's good faith efforts to resolve the matter. The concern raised by these incidents is that they create the appearance that E/A&H is not meeting deliverable deadlines, because the distribution is not occurring until some period of time after the due date. E/A&H has a strong desire to assist the Navy however possible on the NAVBASE Charleston RFI, but, we must also ensure that our contractual obligations are met. I feel we should discuss this situation with contracts personnel to ensure that situations such as these do not continued in the future.
