The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) has reviewed the above referenced document according to applicable State and Federal Regulations, and the Charleston Naval Complex Hazardous Waste Permit, effective September 17, 1998. Based on this review, the Department approves both the EBST and the FOST. Please be advised that any additional information found that could affect the technical adequacy of the FOST could result in further action by the Navy.

In addition, please find the attached copy of the Memorandum of Agreement that was signed by the Department of Navy and the South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control on August 23, 2002 and September 20, 2002 respectively. This agreement was put in place in order to gain a commitment from the Navy to maintain Land Use Controls at sites where residuals of petroleum contamination remain at concentrations that would not be protective for unrestricted land use.
