The Department has reviewed the referenced assessment report. Based upon the geotechnical data in the referenced report and a review of historical information for this site, remediation efforts have eliminated free product and reduced dissolved contamination below applicable MCL and/or RBSL limits.

Based on the information and analytical data submitted, the Department recognizes that the Navy has adequately addressed the known environmental contamination identified on the property to date in accordance with the approved scope of work. Consequently, no further investigation is required at this time. Please note, this statement pertains only to the portion of the site addressed in the referenced report and does not apply to other areas of the site and/or any other potential regulatory violations. Further, the Department retains the right to request further investigation if deemed necessary.

The monitoring well(s) may be permanently abandoned by a certified well driller licensed in South Carolina in accordance with the South Carolina Well Standards and Regulations, R.61-71 or properly maintained. Should you choose to abandon the well(s), please submit a well abandonment record to my attention on or before 28 December 2007. Should you choose to properly maintain the monitoring wells, please notify this office within fourteen days of this correspondence.
