The Department has completed technical review of the referenced document. As submitted, the plan provides for a short term monitoring program to establish intrinsic biodegradation / natural attenuation as the remedial process for groundwater contamination at the subject site. The proposed monitoring program appears reasonable for the known contaminants and the facility may proceed, as appropriate. Results will be utilized to augment existing data in determining if intrinsic biodegradation / natural attenuation is a reasonable corrective action methodology for this site.

The CAP also provided for certain active corrective action methodologies to be employed at the site should intrinsic biodegradation / natural attenuation prove not to be a reasonable corrective action methodology at this site. If it is determined that active measures are necessary, they should be addressed in a CAP addendum submitted to the Department for approval prior to implementation.

Once you have initiated site activities, please provide the Department with a schedule for submittal of the monitoring reports.
