The Department has completed technical review of the referenced document. Interpretation of the analytical data provided in the referenced report indicates that chemicals of concern are below established Risk-Based Screening Levels and MCLs. Due to the historical presence of a hydrocarbon sheen in sample location CNC02-P02, the Department concurs with the recommendation that the wells at this site be gauged in January & February of 2002. During the February 2002 gauging event, a comprehensive sampling of the monitoring well network should be completed. Results of the gauging and sampling event should be submitted to the Department no later than 12 April 2002.
