The Department has completed technical review of the referenced document. As submitted, the Remediation Monitoring Report provides a synopsis of corrective action activities performed to remediate hydrocarbon contamination at the referenced facility.

Interpretation of the analytical data provided in the referenced report indicates that free product persists at this site. The Department concurs with the recommendations of your contractor, free product removal and semi-annual groundwater sampling activities should continue. However, given the shallow groundwater at CNB and the relatively limited extent of free product at this site, the Navy should explore the feasibility of a limited soil removal action to expedite remedial activities.
