The Department has completed technical review of the referenced document. As submitted, the report provides an outline of soil contamination delineation activities designed to define the extent of hydrocarbon contamination in soils at the referenced facility.

The request to initiate soil excavation activities as outlined in the CAP submitted May 2001 is approved. Transportation of excavated soils must be in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. Soils must be disposed of at a permitted treatment facility. Please notify the Department at least 48 hours in advance as to the exact date and time of excavation activities.

Once soil excavation activities have been completed, groundwater monitoring should commence as described in the CAP. The first groundwater monitoring report should be received within 45 days of excavation completion.
