Therefore, we require that you adjust the workplan for SWMU No. 62 to contain the following components:

- 1) Upon locating strong "local magnetic attractions" which suggest buried drums you will uncover, and if appropriate, remove the drums.
- 2) Your workplan must address the contingency of disposing or processing of contaminated soil.
- 3) Your workplan must discuss the procedure for isolating or removing other waste-bearing containers.

We suggest you review the successes and failures experienced at SWMU No. 24, and adjust the workplan for SWMU No. 62 accordingly.

Please note that you will not receive a separate notice of deficiency letter covering your RFI workplan submittal from the U.S.E.P.A. Rather, this and subsequent reviews of your RFI Workplan will be provided exclusively by the TWC.
