

Dear Mr. Key:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated April 20, 1993 concerning the Bioremediation Cleanup Unit. We understand that soil contaminated with fuels, waste oils, and solvents will be treated at the Base. This treatment will consist only of turning of the soil and amending the soil with nutrients, and no permanent structure will be constructed. Since no construction is involved, no permitting or exemption of the source will be required. The treatment, however, must be performed such that a nuisance condition is not created.

An attached letter dated December 10, 1991 from the Permits Division to Revia Trucking explains the position of the TACB on your type of treatment.

Re: Permit Requirements
Soil Weathering Operation

Dear Mr. Mundell:

This is in response to your undated letter which we received November 22, 1991, concerning the proposed operation of a soil weathering operation. We understand that the soil would be transported in mobile equipment from a spill site to a storage area and stirred periodically with farm type mobile equipment. Also, we understand that there would be no construction of facilities to accomplish this weathering operation. This means that the storage area also cannot be a constructed facility (for example, one involving foundations, buildings, sheds, etc.).

After evaluation of the information which you have furnished, we have determined that your proposed operation will not involve construction of facilities that create a new source of air contaminants or increase emissions of air contaminants from existing constructed sources. On this basis, no permit will be required pursuant to the requirements of Texas Air Control (TACB) Board Regulation VI.

It is my understanding that there will be some emissions from weathering of the soil. Therefore, we expect locations to be selected with special concern for possible off-property impacts.

You are reminded that regardless of whether a construction permit is required, this operation must be in compliance with all Rules and Regulations of the TACB at all times. This would include the requirement that the weathering operation must not cause a nuisance pursuant to General Rule 101.4.
