John Doepker, Remedial Project Manager from Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, welcomed everyone present and lead the group through the initial introductions. Kamel Mardini, the Air Force's Environmental Team Leader described the agenda for the evening:

- Welcome/Introductions
- Finalize RAB Charter and Class Selection
- Proposed Plan Revisions
- Open Discussion
- Future Meeting and Agenda

Kay Parsons, Air Force Public Affairs Specialist from Wright-Patterson Air Force Base initiated an effort in which RAB members would be randomly appointed to one, two, or three year terms as provided in the previously developed Air Force Plant 4 Charter. What followed was a lengthy discussion opposing the use of the term "classes" and more importantly the establishment of a RAB Charter that would limit or prohibit future community members from joining the group merely because they had not known of the group.

Mr. Rueben DeLoach was attending his first meeting and raised the concern that the Air Force had not adequately reached out to the community and advertised the RAB meetings. He pointed out that this meeting, like most others were attended by 8 to 12 community members and there was no apparent need to limit initial terms to one or two years.

Mr. DeLoach voiced a final concern about limiting or guarding access to data and information about the restoration of Air Force Plant 4 based on a bad experience at the library two years ago. Mr. Paul Bounds, representing the City of White Settlement assured him it was not library policy to treat the material as anything different than normal reference material. The Air Force also assured Mr. DeLoach that any data he requested would be furnished and a copy of the Administrative Record would be sent to him the following week.

The RAB then modified the Charter by deleting paragraph B and D of Section IV and adding a statement to paragraph F of Section IV that would establish term length of members at 3 years.

The final copy of the Proposed Plan was the next topic on the agenda. A summary of changes to this document included the significant change in Air Force position to adopt the RAB members advise to establish zero emission technologies on new and existing remediation treatment systems.

Mr. Paul Bounds pointed out that Figure 6 on page 11 still shows White Settlement well number 2 as an active production well, when in fact it has been brought off-line. Mr. Jim Scanlan of the City of Fort Worth Water Department voiced concern that while some of his comments were addressed others were not, specifically comments concerning the soil sediments at landfills number three, four, Meandering Road Creek and Lake Worth.

The Air Force stressed the fact that a public meeting would be held at the Senior Services Center on 14 December and encouraged RAB members to attend. The meetings agenda consisted of a poster session from 6 to 7 PM followed by formal presentations from 7 to 9 PM.

The meeting closed with 8 February 1996 being chosen as the next meeting date for the RAB. Agenda topics would include FY96 schedule for Air Force Plant 4. The meeting was adjourned.
