
The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the draft document, "Work Plan Addendum for the Railroad Right of Way Site Assessment and Investigation, Naval Air Station Fort Worth Joint Reserve Base, Carswell Field, Texas September 1997". This document was also discussed during a meeting at the base on October 9, 1997.

Based on this review, EPA provides the following comments:

1. As discussed during the meeting the investigation at the Staging Area near Vickery Boulevard should be modified to start after the start of the spur to the base. The Air Force Right of Way boundary should be determined and the investigation started at that point.
2. As discussed during the meeting additional investigation should be conducted along the spur at the southern end of Carswell Field.
