Dear Mr. Weegar:

I have completed a review of the document, "Draft Closure Report Offsite Weapons Storage Area at NAS Fort Worth Joint Reserve Base Carswell Field, Texas." This report was received by EPA on July 25, 2000. The report proposes closure of several sites to Risk Reduction Standard 1 or 2. The report meets the technical requirements for closure, however this report makes a statement concerning the Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Range that needs to be clarified.

On page 1-15 Clearance of the EOD Range is discussed. Paragraph 1.3.3 indicates the clearance report required no restriction on future land use. My reading of the clearance report also indicates that if land use changed, "EOD personnel should be contacted if the land is to be used for a purpose other than livestock grazing or for other activities which would result in disturbing the ground below a depth of 1 foot." As a further reminder the transfer of this property will require this portion of the site to be restricted from development.
