PROJECT: Rewarehouse 15,285 drums of herbicide orange, currently stored outdoors at the CBC, onto new two by six inch lumber or other comparable dunnage. Determination of how to rewarehouse rests with the Supplying Activity, following applicable guidelines for 55 gallon drum storage in Chapter 5, Section VII, TM 743-200/NAVSUP PUB 284/AFM 67-3. Due to the 638 pound weight factor of each drum, they will be stored only to a three level tier.

ITEM 11. SPECIFIC PROVISIONS, (DD Form 1144) Continued.

Each drum should be stored to have liquid pressure on both bung and vent closures.

Any drum with a leaking bung which cannot be tightened to stop leakage, or a drum with any other type puncture which has leakage, will be re-drummed by the Supply Activity during rewarehousing.

In the rewarehousing process, Supplying Activity will touch up corroded spots on each drum with appropriate colored paint. Care should be taken not to obliterate any markings on the drums.

(1) CBC will furnish:

(a) Sufficient two by six inch lumber, or other comparable dunnage material, to provide dunnage for the entire project cited in Item 11A above.

(b) Whatever other materials, e.g. paint, nails, that are needed to complete the rewarehousing project.

(c) Two portable latrines for use at the CBC work site at a reimbursable rate of \$32.00 each per month.

(d) New bung seals, both large and small, as furnished by SAAMA.

(e) Usable, empty drums from available stock. If and when stock of usable drums is exhausted, then issue new drums as furnished by SAAMA.

(f) Messing for Army reserve personnel for dinner and supper on Saturday; breakfast and dinner on Sunday during the scheduled weekend duty tours.

(g) Housing for Army reserve personnel for Saturday night only on scheduled weekend duty tours. This will be on a non-reimbursable basis.

(2) Supplying Activity will furnish:

(a) Manpower, not to exceed twenty five (25) personnel to perform the work.

(b) Equipment, e.g. cranes and forklifts to accomplish the rewarehousing project.

(3) Receiving Activity will furnish supervisory work guidance to the Army reserve troops during each weekend tour. Troop supervision rests with the Army OIC or NCOIC.

B. DATES OF WEEKEND TOURS:

C. TRANSPORTATION: Supplying Activity will furnish transportation for troops and equipment between his home address and the CBC. He will also furnish transportation between the work location on the CBC and the dining facility/troop housing area while on the CBC installation.

D. EQUIPMENT: Army equipment may be stored on the CBC during the weeks between the tour dates cited in Item 11.B. above. Navy personnel will not use Army equipment nor will Army personnel use Navy equipment.

E. MEDICAL: Emergency medical aid will be available from the CBC during the weekend duty tours. Specific instructions will be made available during the pre-project planning meeting between CBC and Supplying Activity representatives.

F. SAFETY: Personal safety precautions and proper use and care of Government equipment will be practiced by all concerned at all times. Chapter 6, TM 743-200/NAVSUP PUB 284/AFM 67-3 provides applicable guidelines for safety precautions.

G. AUTOMOTIVE FUEL: Gasoline for operation of Government vehicles and equipment by Army reserve personnel will be made available by CBC if needed.
