Dear Sir:

Agent Chemical, Inc., requests permission from yourself and the United States Navy to construct a Pilot Facility on base. This Pilot Facility will be composed of two large skids (5' X 20') with dikes and rails. The principle involved is adsorption of TCDD from Herbicide Orange.

As was explained by Mr. Karl Merrill, the foregoing letter was a proper act of the corporation. The Pilot Plant is a herbicide reprocessing procedure which includes herbicide orange adsorption, infractionation and scrubbing equipment.

We would like to add that a permit has been granted (see attached) from the Air and Water Control Commission in the State of Mississippi to construct this plant.
