1. On 19 August 1975 an informal meeting was held by members of my staff with representatives of your office to discuss the use of USN Construction Battalion Center (NCBC) Gulfport facilities for herbicide orange commercial pilot plant reprocessing operations.
2. Pursuant to the agreement reached, the Commanding Officer, NCBC Gulfport, will provide the necessary space and utilities required. Documents reflecting requirements, submitted by the Agent Chemical Company, were provided to your staff representatives at the meeting.
3. It is requested that a lease agreement, specifying obligations on the part of the contractor, be developed by NCBC Gulfport and submitted directly to the contractor for ratification, with an information copy to this Agency (ATTN: DSAH-SME).
4. Actions have been initiated to formulate the Environmental Impact Assessment, in accordance with applicable DoD Directives. Upon completion, copies will be forwarded to all concerned.
