1. On 29 January 1980, I talked with Commander Don Briselden, the O9A at the Southern Division, NAVFAC, concerning the demolition of building 239. SOUTHDIV does not feel they have sufficient information to include the demolition of building 239 in the contract at this time. They state that they have not done enough 'homework' on what's involved. One of the things they have to investigate is whether or not the building itself is contaminated which will, of course, influence the method of disposal. I am not sure if other problems are involved which require more 'homework.' Commander Briselden did say that they will research the problem and intend to include the demolition of the building in the contract through a change order.
