SUBJECT: Decontamination of Excessed Equipment Naval Construction Battalion Center (NCBC)

TO: HQ USAF/SGES

1. Attached is a copy of a message we received from NCBC, Gulfport MS (Atch 1), requesting a plan of action and schedule for the decontamination and removal of excessed equipment now located on a former herbicide orange storage area. Before we can develop a plan and schedule we require guidance on decontamination requirements and personnel monitoring. Specifically, we have the following questions:

a. Does equipment stored in this area have to be decontaminated before removal? If so, how?

b. Does Air Force need to develop a personnel monitoring program for personnel who work in the area?

c. Do personnel who have worked in the contaminated area need to be identified and tracked?

d. Does equipment, previously stored in the area and redistributed, need to be identified and decontaminated?

2. To assist you in these determinations, we have supplied a rough map showing preliminary test results (Atch 2). Additional test results are available from AFESC/RDV (Major Walker or Capt Stoddard, AV 970-4628/2942).

3. Several of the excessed pieces of equipment have been sold and more are awaiting redistribution. Consequently, NCBC has requested a rapid response. We very much appreciate your assistance in answering these questions so that we can press on with a solution.
