Gulfport Dioxin Vehicle Cleanup SOW

1. The following attended the meeting at Naval Construction Battalion Center, Gulfport, Mississippi, on September 20, 1985: R. S. Burns, D. W. Burton, J. H. Cluff, Captain D. Foth, Major R. Vogel.
2. We reviewed the draft Statement of Work (SOW) dated Sept. 18, 1985. The following items were discussed with the action as indicated.

a. No government service or equipment to be provided to the Contractor. Electrical to be metered.	Cluff to provide boilerplate to Burns.
b. Provide dates for background section.	Cluff
c. Add requirement for contractor to submit a plan.	Burns to include in Statement of Work
d. Require steam (delete option for soap) as decontamination method.	Vogel decision.
e. Add requirement for mask (dust mask) worn by workers.	Vogel decision.
f. Perform more detailed inventory and marking of all items. Spray paint was suggested as a way to indicate disposition.	Burns
g. Arrange for site visit by potential contractors as part of the bid process.	Burns, Cluff, Vogel, to coordinate
h. Compare our Statement of Work with Times Beach Statement of Work.	Burns to get Times Beach Statement of Work.
i. Do we need a definition or example of word "exposed?"	Burns to propose appropriate words.

- j. If cleaned vehicle is sampled for dioxin and comes back positive - vehicle will be redecontaminated and then not sampled again. Vogel - decision
- k. Contractor to submit clearances/permit as part of plan to do Statement of Work. Burns
- l. Any contact with news media will be handled by PA at Tyndall AFB, Major Jim Haeberg. Vogel decision
- m. Need to get references in RCRA and Mississippi-application of RCRA for inclusion in Statement of Work. Burns
- o. Level of dioxin of decontaminated items not to exceed 1 ppb. Vogel decision
- p. Captain Foth is to provide the reference for the 1 ppb level. Foth
- q. Jim Cluff to provide Burns the name of the Mississippi EPA person. Cluff
- r. Jim Cluff to provide Burns (for Statement of Work) the standards for tiedown. Cluff
- s. Jim Cluff to provide 12 copies of blueprints of NCBC, Gulfport, to Burns Cluff
- t. Burns to ensure that final draft of Statement of Work coordinated with NCBC and AFESC. Burns
- u. Cluff to provide boilerplate to Burns for rules and regulations for contractors performing work on NCBC. Cluff
- v. Burns to provide a draft statement that AFESC can use to Defense Redisposition Office indicating that items have been decontaminated. (This is not to be included in the Statement of Work. Burns

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2. We had a meeting with Lt. CDR K. O. Galer, Acting Executive Officer. J. Cluff explained project; Major Vogel also clarified what is to be done. Lt. CDR Galer is the Public Works Officer at NCBC.
