1. HQ AFESC/RDVW erected a temporary fence around a portion of the former Herbicide Orange storage site. The fence was placed to prevent entry to the salvage storage area pending the results of soil testing for dioxin. AFESC/RDVW and AFESC/DEV have reviewed this data and identified a large block of the salvage area that is clean and no longer requires fencing (see attached map).
2. It is my intent to have Ecology and Environment, one of the AFESC contractors, to relocate the temporary fence which will provide access to clean salvage materials/equipment located in the area. Ecology and Environment will accomplish this small task at our direction when they visit NCBC to collect samples in the near future.
