1. The discharge of treated air scrubber water from the ENSCO incinerator into the NCBC sanitary sewer system has been recommended and will be fully permitted by EPA Region 4. Discharge of the scrubber water into a publicly-owned treatment works (POTW) is allowed by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), Part 261.4, subparagraph ii.
2. HQ AFESC/RD signed the RCRA permit application which designates the US Air Force as the operator of the incineration research project. Any activity that takes place under the auspices of the RCRA permit is the responsibility of the US Air Force. This would include responsibility for any adverse environmental impact that results from the permitted research activity.
3. It is my understanding that Mr Cluff, Code 470, is requesting approval for the POTW discharge from the city of Gulfport and the Regional Wastewater District. Please advise me if there are any problems with local approvals. My point of contact is Capt Stoddart, AUTOVON 970-2942.
