1. As discussed during reference (a), the Air Force believes additional sections of the open storage area, other than the original tract, were used to store Herbicide Orange. Composite samples taken by the Air Force has confirmed that some contamination exists outside of the original area.

2. Request temporary barriers be erected around those additional open storage areas designated by Capt Terry Stoddart (AFESC/RDVW) as being suspected of Herbicide Orange contamination. The barriers should be substantial enough to guard against unauthorized entry into the areas but flexible enough to allow mission-essential tasks to be performed.
