90% VERIFICATION WORK PLAN COMMENTS  
CBC GULFPORT, MS

Comments on the 90% Verification Work Plan are divided into general and specific comments. The general comments are as follows:

1. The number of sampling points should be reduced as agreed upon in telephone conversations between Mr. Gary Goodheart and Mr. James Malone.
2. The locations of the monitoring wells should be noted as tentative. Actual locations may have to be shifted depending upon activity mission requirements and field conditions. The work plan should reflect this.
3. The work plan should address barriers and markers necessary to protect the monitoring wells.

The following specific comments are referred to the appropriate page numbers in the 90% plan:

1. Page 1 - Please include that site 8 is already under remedial measures by USAF.
2. Page 3, Section A - Site 8 will be left out the NACIP investigation entirely including field inspection. This applies throughout the plan.
3. Page 4 - Please list the site numbers at which the geophysical survey will be done.
4. Page 5, Section C - Please strike out "HLA recommends that" and start the sentence with "Test boring will".
5. Page 5 - Please strike out all reference to upgradient wells here and elsewhere in the plan.
6. Page 6 - Please remove the sentence starting with "The proposed locations...". This sentence does not add to the plan.
7. Page 12, Site 9 - A letter which gives activity action at this site will be provided for justification of the recommendation of no action at this site.
8. Page 15 -
  - a) A more detailed description of HLA's responsibilities in properly identifying, labeling, packaging and turning over all hazardous waste to Public Works for disposal should be included. To insure this is properly described, Mr. Jim Cluff at 601-865-2484 should be contacted.
  - b) A statement should be added that all hazardous waste will be disposed of through DRMO. In the event DRMO will not accept the waste, CBC Gulfport will dispose of the waste with funding from the NACIP program at SOUTHNAVFACENGCOM.
  - c) CBC Gulfport does not have a permitted storage facility for hazardous waste. This requires all hazardous waste to be off station within 90 days of the accumulation start date. The plan should note this disposal requirement.
