Dear Sir:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with official notice that the site listed above is included on the Wastelan Preremedial Report (CERCLIS). CERCLIS is a listing of potential hazardous waste sites maintained by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

Sites on CERCLIS were entered into the system for one of the following reasons:

1. The site owner or a generator using the site notified EPA as required under Section 103(c) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) (the Federal Superfund);
2. The site owner notified EPA or the Mississippi Department of Natural Resources as required under Section 3010 of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA);
3. A citizen complaint on the site was filed with EPA or our office.

The Bureau of Pollution Control investigates these site under EPA's Superfund Preremedial Program for potential placement on the National Priorities List of Superfund Sites. Under current EPA policy once a site has been listed in CERCLIS, it remains on the list indefinitely, and only its status on this list changes based on the most current update of information submitted by the State or developed by EPA.

The Bureau has recently received numerous inquiries from interested parties concerning sites on the CERCLIS List, especially in reference to environmental audits and real estate transactions. The Bureau's policy is to provide information upon request as to how and when the site was listed on CERCLIS and what actions have been taken subsequent to the listing. It usually takes four to six weeks for us to respond to this kind of request for information.
